


WELCOME TO THE PRECISION KICKS FAMILY

Inside your Precision Kicks pack you'll find a pair of Precision Kicks triggers with dual lock velcro attachments, an alcohol wipe and a spare strip of velcro.

The following steps will provide you with the quickest and easiest way to set up your new pair of triggers on your kick pedals.

Step 1: Loosen the adjustment arm and raise the trigger head by just a few millimetres then tighten once more (the lever should be tightened until it gives a decent resistance).


This will give you a starting point for adjustment once the triggers are on the boards.



Step 2: Rest your kick beater loosely against the kick skin and find a spot where the most surface area of the pedal board is able to make contact with the trigger head while the trigger body is flat against the pedal base.



<u>Step 3:</u> Give the spot on your board base a quick clean with the included alcohol swab to remove any residue or dust which could interfere with the adhesion of the trigger. Remove the plastic covering from the bottom velcro piece and place the trigger module in the desired location.



Step 4: The remaining height and angle headroom will allow you to fine tune the position of the trigger head now that it's seated on the base.

Digging down or squashing too hard into the trigger head with the board could lead to unnecessary damage to your triggers, only a light impact with the trigger head is required for accurate triggering.

<u>Step 5:</u> Finally, connect the trigger output jack to your drum module via a mono instrument cable (a guitar lead will do just fine) and adjust your module's settings to best suit your playing. We recommend starting with a moderately to low threshold and moderate sensitivity and fine tuning from there.
